You must select your FLVS classes on the **FLVS Lab Subject Selection** form and return it with your Subject Selection form to be enrolled in an FLVS Lab class. Choose your course carefully! No changes can be made.

In order to remain in good standing and continue at Jose Marti MAST 6 – 12 Academy I must:

- Maintain a minimum 2.5 Un-weighted GPA.
- Maintain appropriate attendance in all classes, including tardies.
- Respect the Student Code of Conduct: Level 3 Violations or higher equal a transfer back to your home school.
