

- Organization is the key!
- Agendas
  - Write down all your assignments <u>every</u>
     <u>day</u>!!
- Bookbags
  - Some students find it easier to have separate bags for Odd and Even days.
- Color coding folders

- Good Attendance
  - Be in school and on time every day

  - Don't wait until the last minute

- Set up Gradebook alerts on the Parent Portal

## Attendance is Important!

#### When you aren't in school, you are falling behind!

- Absences are UNEXCUSED until documentation is brought in.
- Students must bring in a note from the parent or a doctor and obtain an Admit before school in the cafeteria to have an absence excused.
- Excessive unexcused absences or tardies may result in academic probation. Students on probation will be excluded from extracurricular activities and events (including fieldtrips).
- Students who accumulate 10 or more unexcused absences or tardies in a school year may not be invited to return.

# Requirements to Remain in Good Standing

Jose Marti MAST is an Advanced Academics school. As such, students are expected to maintain excellent grades, conduct, and attendance.

- Middle School students must have a 2.0 GPA in each core class.
- High School students must have a 2.5
   GPA in each core class.
- Students must not receive any Ds or Fs in any subject or in conduct.





# Requirements to Remain in Good Standing

Jose Marti MAST is an advanced academics school. As such, students are expected to maintain excellent grades, conduct, and attendance.



- Students must have all 1s and 2s in effort.
- 8<sup>th</sup> Graders must have a 2.5 GPA in each core class to remain with us for High School.
- Students must have fewer than 10 unexcused absences and tardies for the school year.

# Requirements to Remain in Good Standing

Jose Marti MAST is an advanced academics school. As such, students are expected to maintain excellent grades, conduct, and attendance.

- Students who do not meet these requirements will be placed on academic probation for the following quarter.
- <u>Students on probation for two quarters or more may not be invited to return the following school year.</u>








## Supplies






