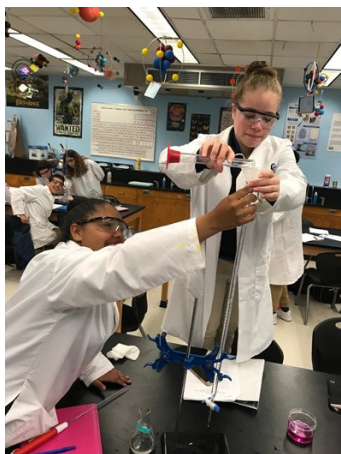

## Electronic Gradebook

Parents can access their child's electronic Gradebook at any time with a Parent Portal account. You can monitor the account through the internet or the Dadeschools Mobile app on your smart phone.

### To sign up for a Parent Portal Account:

- Visit [www.dadeschools.net](http://www.dadeschools.net)
- Click on Parents (orange box)
- Click "Create Account" (under the Login button)
- Read the Acceptable Use Policy -click "I Agree"
- Complete the Parent Portal Registration System application.
- Check your mail for the verification and click on the link.
- Sign in to your new Portal Account.
- There will be no students linked to your account until you let the system know who your child is!
- Click Add Student.
- For each child you wish to add to your account, you will need the following information:

<b>Student ID#</b>	<b>Date of Birth</b>
<b>Place of Birth</b>	<b>Parent PIN Number</b>
- Parent PIN can only be obtained from the school where your child is currently enrolled.
- Parents with students new to M-DCPS will not be able to get a PIN until after the first day of school when the student officially becomes an M-DCPS student!

### Email Notifications

Once you have set up your Parent Portal account and have access to the Electronic Gradebook, don't forget to sign up for Email Notifications. The Gradebook will email you periodically with a list of your child's grades. (We recommend once a week.) If you see a grade that concerns you, login to the Portal to see why!
