

2023-2024 UNIFORM POLICY

TOPS:

- School-approved short-sleeved polo with the school crest. Polos must be in navy blue or light gray for middle school and royal blue and dark gray for high school.
- School-approved long-sleeved polo with the school crest. Polos must be in navy blue or light gray for middle school and royal blue and dark gray for high school.
- School-approved club or school t-shirt on Tuesdays, paid dress-down Fridays or any other day allowed by the school.

PANTS:

- Khakis
- Navy blue pants
- Jeans on t-shirt Tuesdays (FREE) and dress-down Fridays (\$2). Jeans must have NO rips, holes, or tears and be BLUE denim. Jeans will only be allowed on T-shirt Tuesdays if the student is wearing a school or school club t-shirt as a top.
- School-issued sweatpants sold by PTSA ONLY on t-shirt Tuesdays (FREE) or dress-down Fridays (\$2). **Any other sweatpants will NOT be allowed.**

SWEATERS:

- School-approved hoodies with school crest. Hoodies must be in navy blue, royal blue, gray or black.
- Plain hoodies in navy blue, royal blue, gray or black.
- Open jacket in navy blue, royal blue, gray or black.
- * Small insignias like logos in one location allowed, but NO large prints or patterns throughout the sweater or jacket will be allowed.

SHOES:

- Closed-toe shoes or sneakers. NO sandals, Crocs, flip flops, or open-toes shoes are allowed.

ADDITIONAL NOTES: No dresses or skirts allowed. We understand there may be special circumstances. Any deviation from the uniform policy for personal, financial, or religious reasons MUST be discussed with and cleared by an Administrator.
