INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBJECT SELECTION

Please complete the subject selection form and via the subject selection link by the designated deadline. Students who do not complete their subject selection form in a timely manner will be placed in any elective with available space. No schedule changes will be made if you do not complete the subject selection process.

REQUIRED/CORE CLASSES:

- All students at Jose Marti MAST 6-12 Academy take Advanced level classes for Language Arts, Math, Science, and Social Studies.
- Students who have already been placed in the Gifted program should select Gifted instead of Advanced.
- Students who are in the ESOL program should select ELL Language Arts.
- In addition to the required core classes, 6th graders also take 2 other required classes: Science Lab, and Physical Education.

ELECTIVES:

- There are several elective options available for 6th grade students. Please number your top 4 choices from #1-4 in order of your preference. You will be scheduled in 2 of these classes. Students who do not complete the subject selection process will be placed in any elective with available space.
- Please make your selection wisely. Schedule changes for electives will not be made if you change your mind.
- Students who receive a Level 1 or 2 on the FSA ELA test will take a Reading class instead of an elective.
- ESOL Students (English Language Learners) will take Developmental ESOL instead of an elective.

ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS:

In order to remain in good standing and continue at Jose Marti MAST 6 – 12 Academy I must:

- Maintain a minimum 2.0 unweighted GPA in each core class.
- Maintain appropriate attendance in all classes. Students with excessive absences and/or tardies will be placed on probation for the following quarter.
- Maintain a minimum of C for all conduct grades.
- Students whose GPA falls below 2.0 for core classes or have any Ds or Fs on their report card will be placed on probation for the following quarter.
- Respect the Student Code of Conduct: Level 3 Violations or higher equal a transfer back to your home school.

Students who are placed on probation for grades, conduct or attendance are NOT allowed to participate in any extra curricular activities or events for the following quarter. (This includes fieldtrips, athletic teams, field day, or any other non-academic activity.)

I understand that enrollment in any advanced course (Honors) for next school year, is **temporary**, pending **MY END OF THE YEAR GRADES for the current school year**. By the end of grade 8 (before I go to grade 9), I **must have passed** Algebra 1 **AND** Biology with a final grade of a "C" or higher as well as a passing score on the End of Course exams. Students who are unable to pass Algebra 1 and Biology (and EOC) will unable to remain at JMMAST for High School.

PARENTS:
