2025-2026 UNIFORM POLICY

TOPS:

- School-approved short-sleeved polo (or long-sleeved polo) with the school crest. Polos must be in navy or light gray for middle school and royal blue and dark gray for high school.
- School-approved club/class t-shirt on Tuesdays (FREE).

PANTS:

- Khakis or navy pants
- Jeans are allowed on t-shirt Tuesdays (FREE) if the student is wearing a school polo with the crest or a club/class t-shirt. Jeans must have NO rips or holes and be BLUE denim.
- JMMAST branded sweatpants sold by PTSA ONLY on t-shirt Tuesdays (FREE). Any other sweatpants will NOT be allowed on Tuesdays.

OUTER WEAR:

- School-approved hoodies & jackets with school crest. These are sold by PTSA and Student Activities. Hoodies must be in navy, royal blue, gray, or black.
- Any hoodie or jacket **NOT** sold by the school may **ONLY** be **PLAIN** and in the following colors: navy, royal blue, gray or black. A small logo is allowed, but **NO** large prints or patterns throughout the hoodie or jacket will be allowed.
- College hoodies, sweaters or jackets are allowed any day of the week. This is the only exception to the color and pattern rule.

SHOES:

- Closed-toe shoes or sneakers. NO sandals, NO flip flops, or open-toes shoes are allowed. Crocs are only allowed on FRIDAYS as part of the dress-down fundraiser. You must pay \$2 to wear Crocs on Fridays ONLY.

DRESS DOWN FRIDAYS:

- On Fridays, students will be allowed to dress-down for a fee of \$2. Wristbands are sold in the front of the school on Friday mornings. What is allowed as part of the paid dress-down?
- Jeans (any color with no rips), sweatpants or uniform pants. NO SHORTS!
- School appropriate top/t-shirt (no rips, no spaghetti straps, no tube-tops, no bellies exposed)
- Crocs in sport mode and must have the JMMAST jibbitz purchased from the PTSA. Crocs cannot be worn during PE or during science lab classes where chemicals are involved. *If you are in full uniform, and choose to wear Crocs on Fridays, you must pay \$2.*

ADDITIONAL NOTES: No dresses or skirts allowed, unless it's part of a designated dress down day, like Spirit Week or Halloween. We understand there may be special circumstances. Any deviation from the uniform policy for personal, financial, or religious reasons MUST be discussed with and cleared by an Administrator. There will be clear, consistent, and progressive consequences for not abiding by the school's uniform policy for the 2025-2026 school year.
