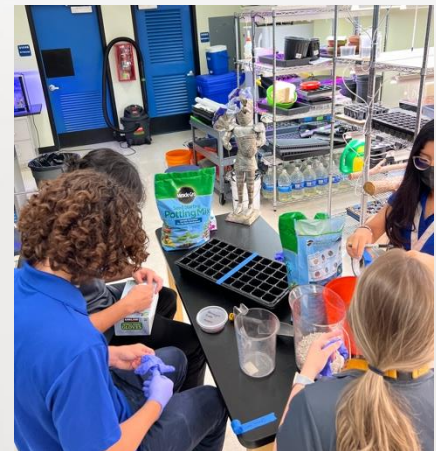

CALCULATING GRADES - 10 POINT RULE



- Each nine-week period is worth 25% for a total of 100%
- You must earn a total of 10 points for each course to pass
- 5 points must come from the 3rd & 4th nine-weeks

ATTENDANCE IS VITAL!

- 🛡️ Absences shall be reported to the school by your parent, no later than three (3) days from the date of the absence.
- 🛡️ To report an absence, your parent sends an email stating the cause for the absence directly to:
7291attendance@dadeschools.net
- 🛡️ Email needs to include student's full name, id number, date of the absence, and the reason of the absence.
- 🛡️ Failure to report and explain the absence will result in an unexcused absence(s) for each day not reported. The principal shall have final authority for determining acceptability of the reason for the absence(s).

Early Sign Out

The early release of students causes disruption to the academic performance. **No student shall be released within the final 30 minutes of the school day (1:50 pm) unless authorized by the principal.** Only authorized individuals as listed on the student's Emergency Contact Card may sign a student out of school.



TARDY TO SCHOOL POLICY

- 🏛️ Students arriving to school late between 7:20AM & 7:30AM are to report directly to their first block teacher.
- 🏛️ Each teacher will apply the tardy policy along with other consequences based on circumstances and frequency of past tardies.
- 🏛️ Students arriving to school after 7:30AM must be with a parent and report to the main office to be processed. Without a parent? Report to the Auditorium for processing and consequences.

UNIFORM POLICY



Royal Blue or Dark Gray Polo Shirt

*shirts must display the MAST logo

Khaki or Navy Blue Pants

*no shorts, capris, skirts, or jeans

Shoes – Closed Toe Shoes Required

*Sneakers Preferred

*No Sandals, Crocs, Open-Toes, or back straps



Jackets & Sweaters

must be navy blue, white, gray, or black **ONLY**.

*Can be a hoodie, open-front sweater, or pullover sweater, but MUST abide by the color requirements and cannot have prints all over the garment. (one logo/insignia is fine). College sweatshirts and hoodies are the exception to the color rule.

Students may not wear the hood on their heads.

ID Badge – MUST BE WORN EVERYDAY.

It is officially part of your uniform.

are not Free on Fridays!**



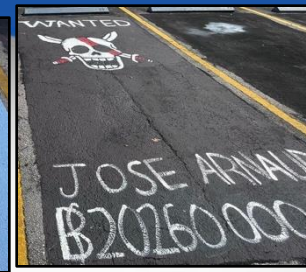
PARTICIPATION IN EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES



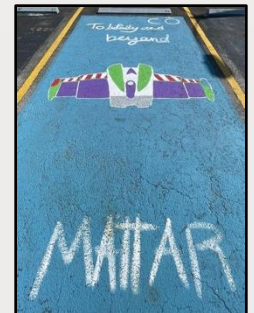
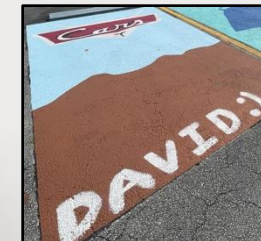
- Adhere to the Absences and tardies policy.

PARKING

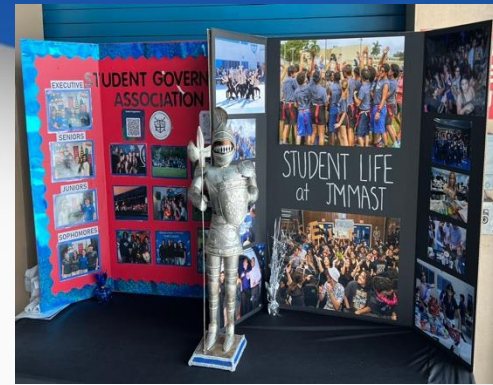


- Student parking spaces are rows with gray, numbered bumpers in the main parking lot (#1- 75).
