Classroom Attendance:

7. Highlighters – any color

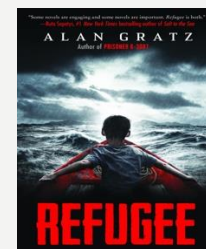
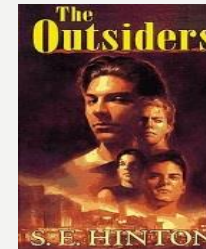

Novels:

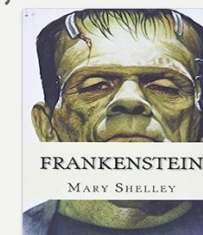
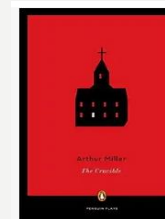
Seventh Grade Only:

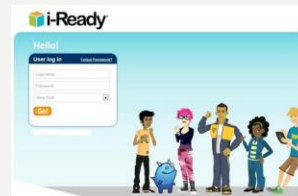

Online / Technology Requirements

1. Students must have a functioning computer everyday. – **ELA & Theater**
2. Student and parents should check the portal regularly. – **ELA & Theater**
3. Students have access to the textbook on their student portal. **ELA & Theater**
4. **i-Ready**: (**Seventh grade only**) After the diagnostic test is taken, students must complete 60 minutes minimum every week. They have from Monday morning to 11:59 p.m. Sunday. They can access this program from their portal or login.i-ready.com. – **Starts in October.**
5. **CommonLit**: Students will be assigned lessons and given a complete by date. Some lessons are online others are printed. Sign up codes were given on 8/25 & students instructed to sign up by 9/1. – **ELA**
6. **Schoology**: Various assignments are assigned on the Schoology platform. Students should check Schoology regularly for updates, assignment information, and school information. – **ELA & Theater**

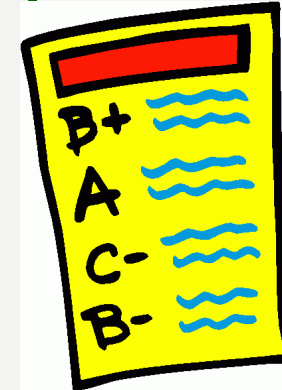

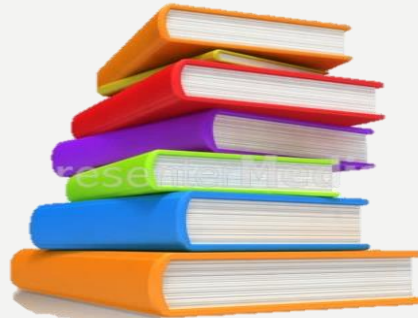
