

COURSE OVERVIEW

The AP Spanish Language and Culture exam tests your linguistic and cultural knowledge through multiple-choice questions, interpersonal speaking and writing, and presentational speaking and writing. The spoken part includes an interpersonal conversation and a presentational cultural comparison. For the presentational speaking, you will deliver a two-minute presentation, comparing a cultural feature of a Spanish-speaking community to your own, requiring a structured response with a thesis, developing points, and a conclusion.



EXAM FORMAT AND SKILLS

Multiple Choice: Consists of print and audio texts, testing comprehension.

Interpersonal Communication:

Speaking: Engage in a simulated conversation, with a limited time (20 seconds) for each of your five responses.

Writing: Compose an email reply.

Presentational Communication:

Speaking: Give a two-minute presentation where you compare a cultural feature of a Spanish-speaking community to another community.

Writing: Write an argumentative essay.
